HOW TO USE

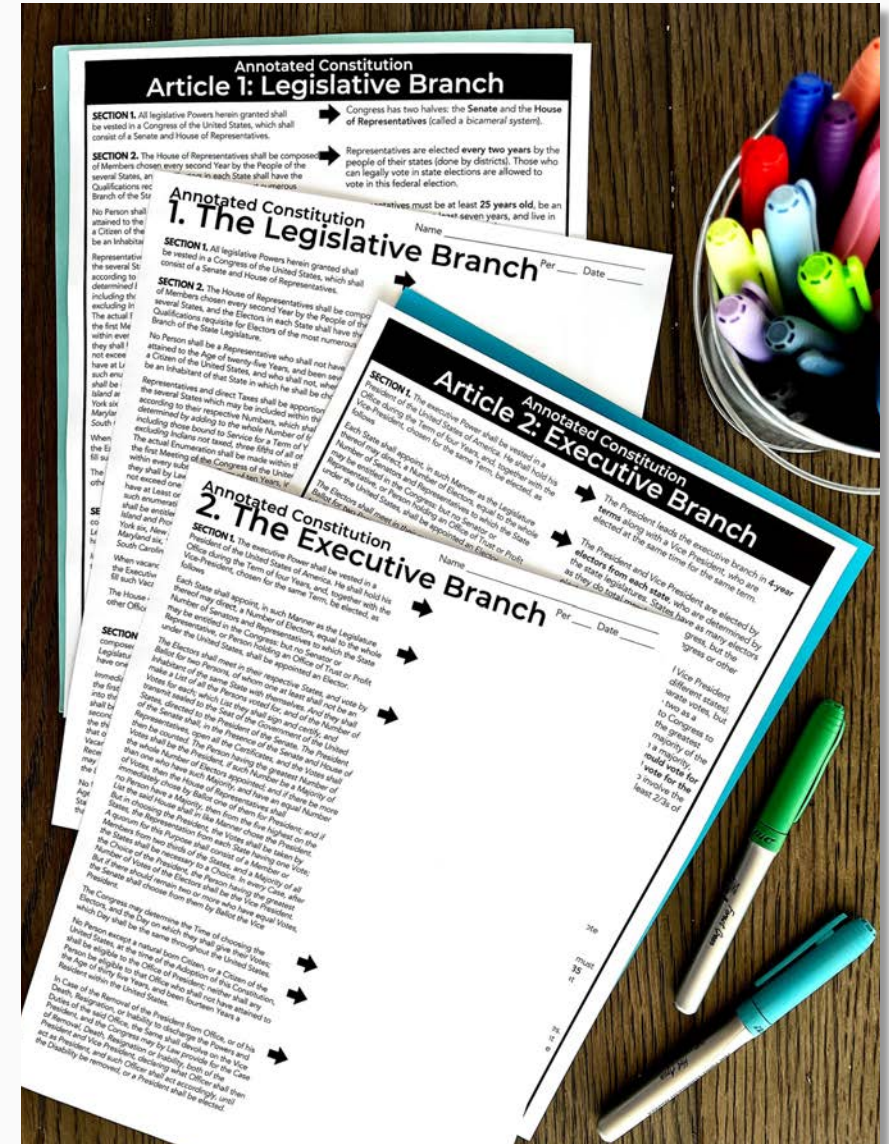
Kick off each unit by reading and paraphrasing what the Constitution says
