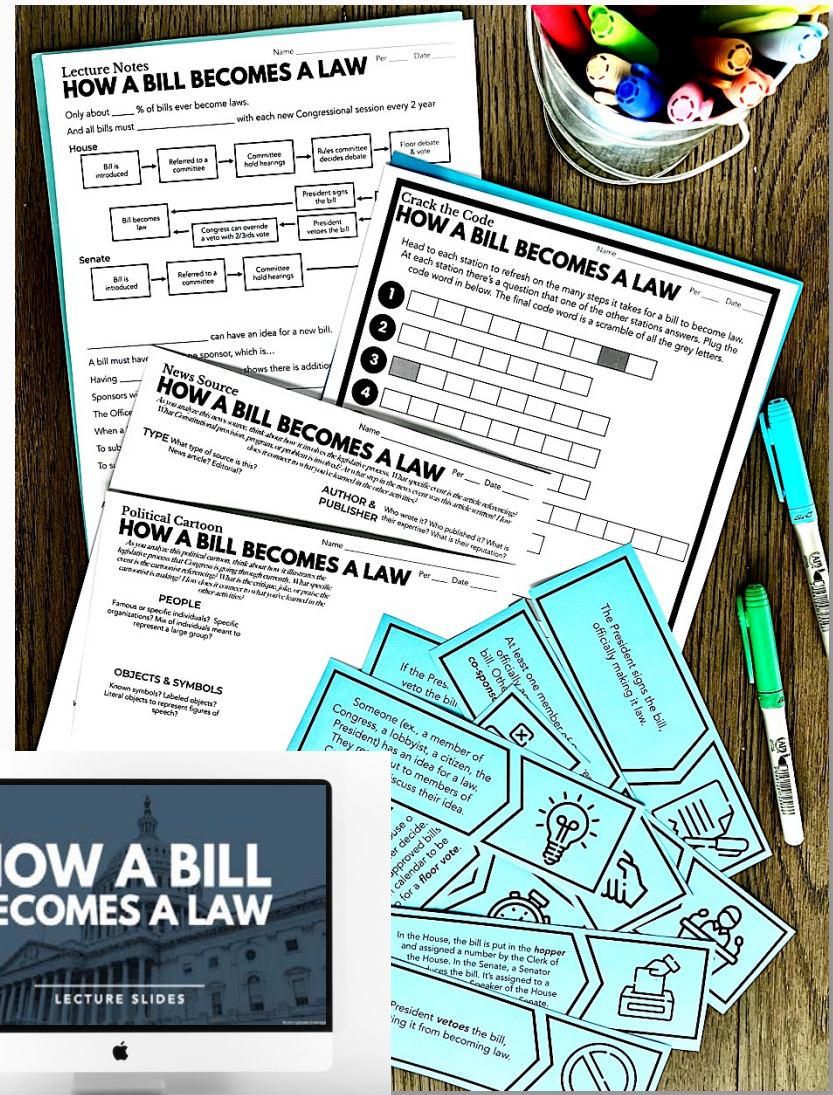

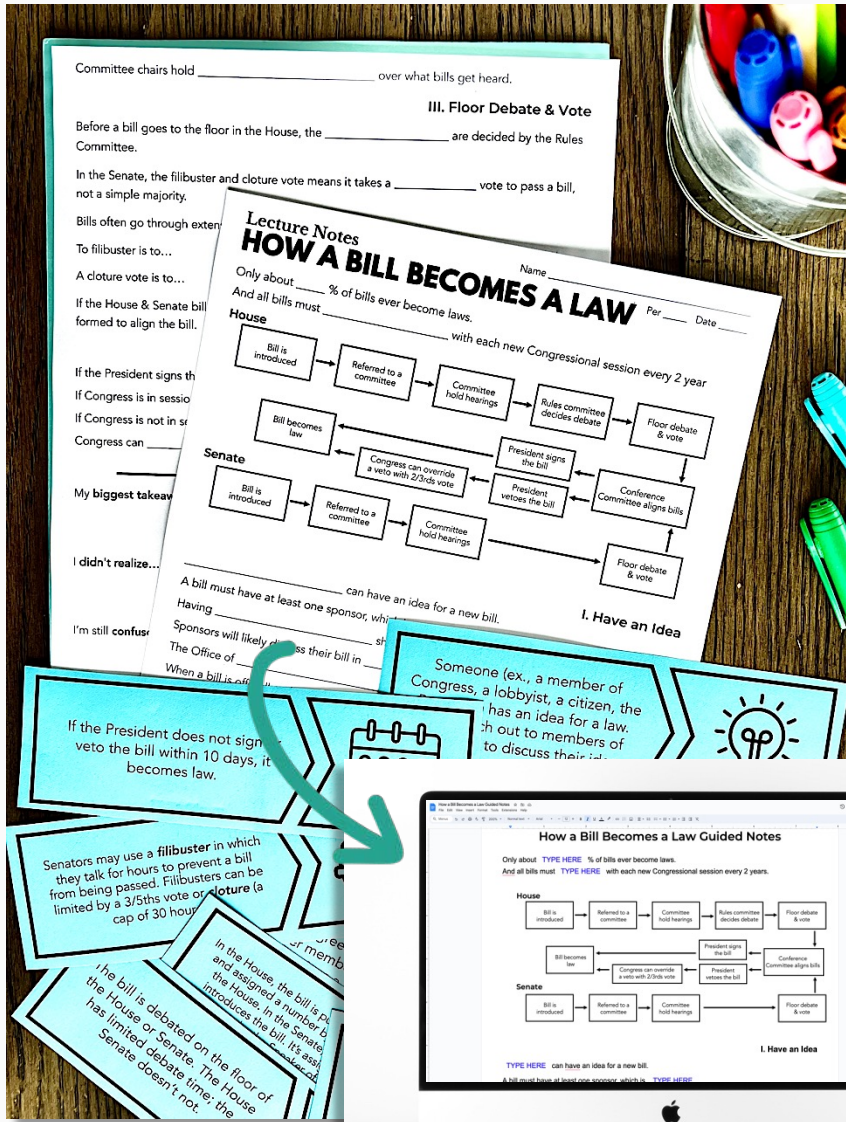

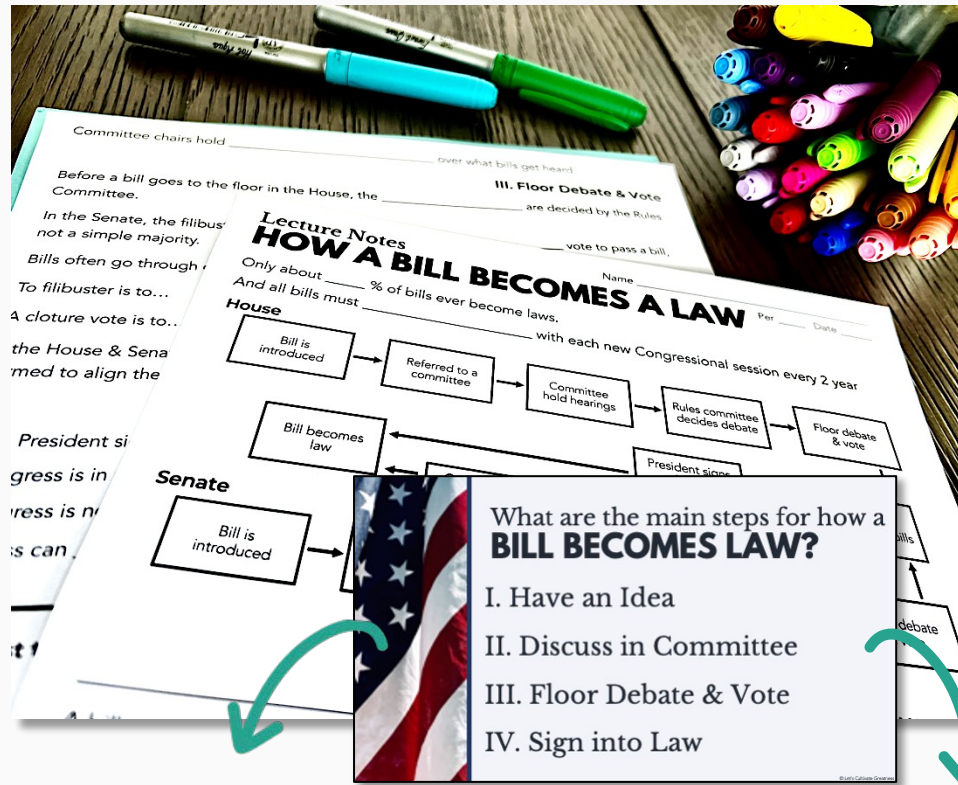

The Consolidated Appropriations Act of 2021 is thought to be the longest bill passed at 5,608 pages

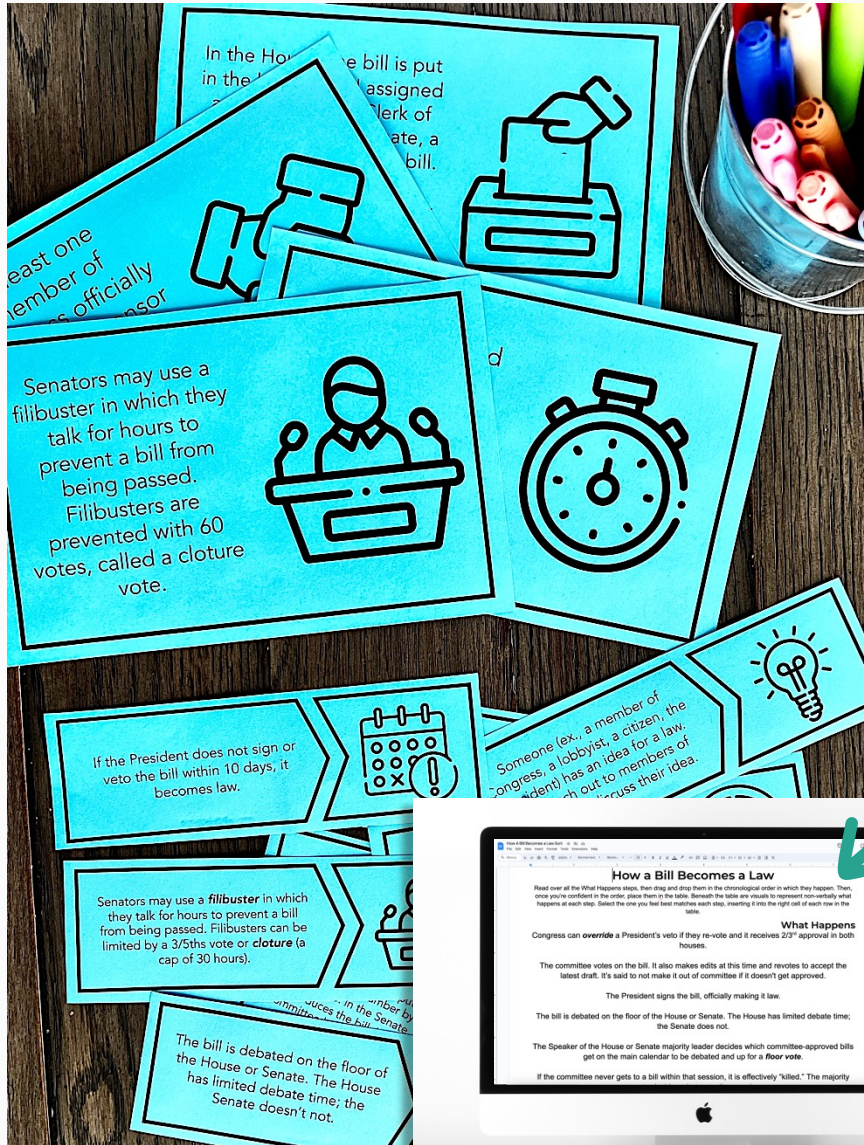
I. HAVE AN IDEA

Someone comes up with an idea
Must have a sponsor, may have co-sponsors
Likely discussed within a caucus
Officially submitted & assigned a committee

IV. SIGN OR VETO

The President has the final say
An unsigned bill becomes law after 10 days or can be "pocket" vetoed
Vetoes require 2/3rds override

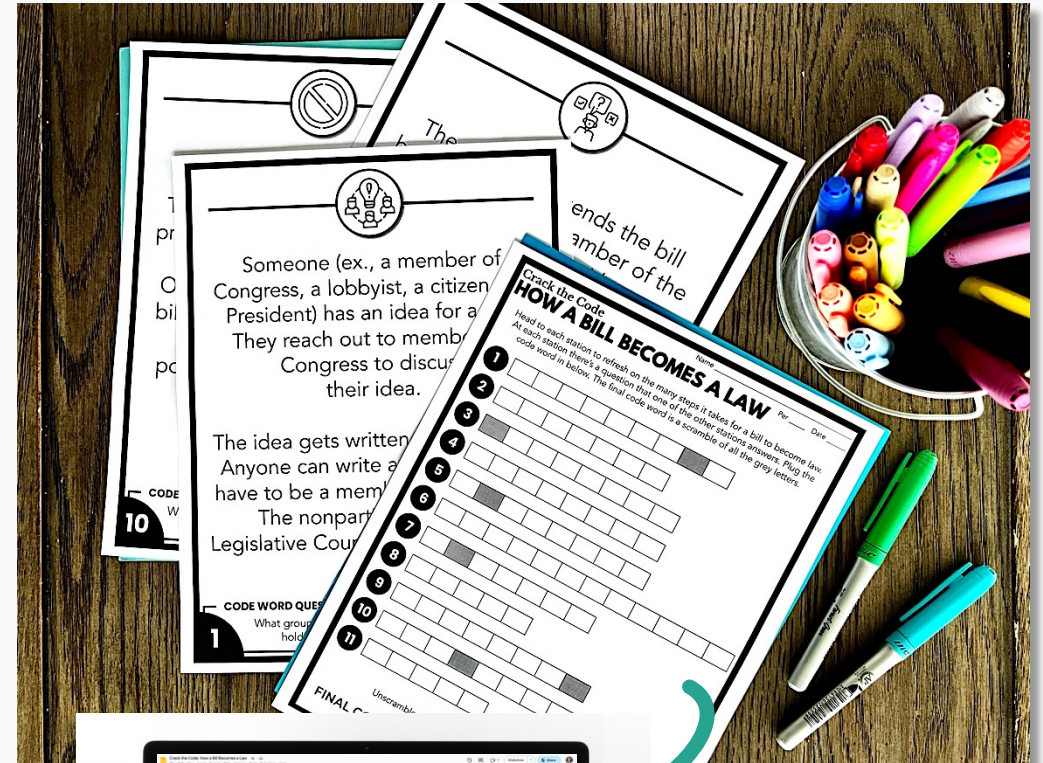

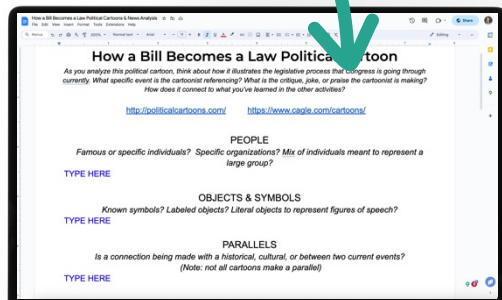
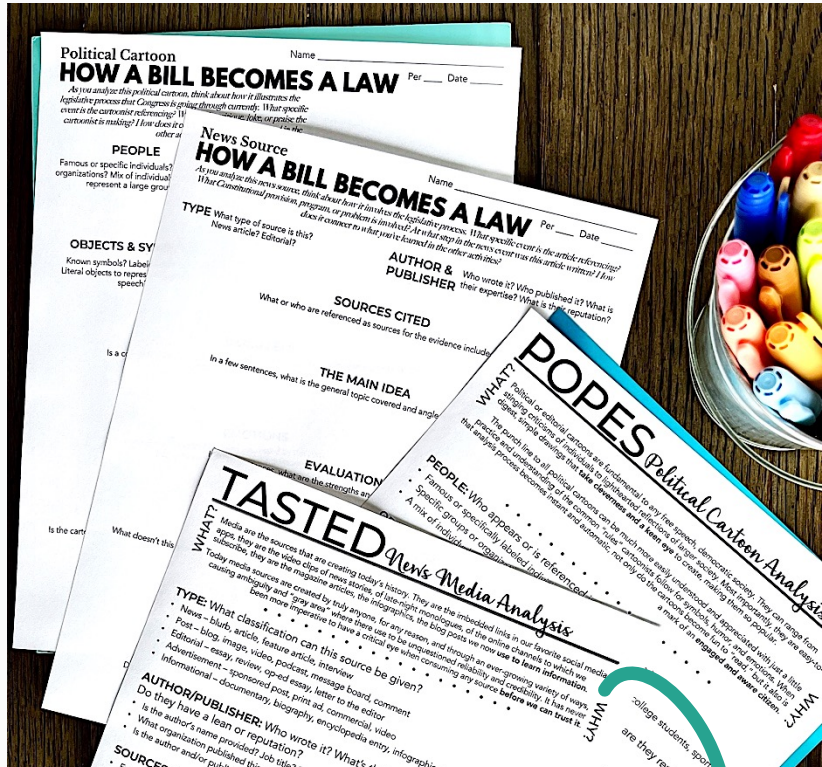
